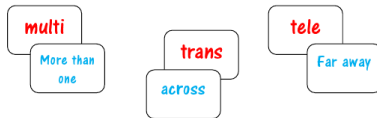


Greek and Latin Root Word Memory Card Game

Level One

Greek and Latin Root Word Memory Card Game

Objective: To form matching pairs of root words and their meanings.

Players: Two to Six

Materials: 36 Memory Cards

Rules of Play:

1. Shuffle the cards in the deck.
 2. Place all cards face down in straight rows to form a grid pattern.
 3. Players take turns turning over the cards, one by one.
 4. As the first card is turned over, the player reads the root aloud. The player then says the meaning of the root he is looking for.
 5. Player then turns over a second card. If the card is a match, the player takes both cards, and gets another turn. If the card is not a match, the player reads the root aloud, and the possible match, then turns both cards over.
- * Other players are encouraged to help with roots and meanings. If player is unsure of the meaning of the root, other players should help (thus deepening their own knowledge of the roots)
6. The next player goes, repeating steps 4 and 5.
 7. Play continues until the entire board is cleared.

Winner: The player with the most cards collected is the winner.
